

Champion Chats



A discussion guide for parents and kids!

During The NED Show assembly, children learn about a cartoon character named NED, whose name stands for three important character messages:

Never give up * Encourage others * Do your best®

Discussing NED with your children - having a "Champion Chat" as we like to call it - is a fantastic way to deepen character traits (focus/perseverance, kindness/shared learning & diligence/excellence) in your kids!

DETAILS

Ask your child to tell you what happened in show.

- What happened during NED's adventure? (e.g. Round the world, Eiffel Tower, aliens!)
- What was the funniest moment of the show? What does NED's name stand for?
- What was your favorite magic trick during the show? Have you been able to figure it out?

MESSAGES

Connect the dots between NED's story and character traits!

- What did NED learn from his whole adventure?
- Which part of NED's message do you want to focus on the most? How can you start putting that message into action?

YO-YOS

Make the yo-yo excitement count toward important life skills!

- How do you think a "never give up" attitude has helped the performer become an expert at vo-voing?
- Think of a hobby, sport or school subject that is currently a big challenge for you. When things are really tough, how will you encourage yourself to never give up?
