

Large Question Cube

WHAT YOU'LL NEED:

- 12" x 12" x 12" plain box (Staples or UPS)
- large format (11x17) color printer or send this pdf to a copy/print store to print on 11x17 paper
- laminator (optional)
- scissors or exact-o knife
- tape (clear packing tape is preferable)
- jingle bells/noise maker (optional) for inside box

DIRECTIONS:

1. Print these 6 pages in color on 11x17 inch paper.
2. Cut out square on each page.
3. Laminate, each square for durability (optional.)
4. Place jingle bells or other noise maker inside box and tape box closed.
5. Tape one square to each side of the 12" x 12" x 12" box. (See figure A, page 2)
6. Designate 5' x 5' area (marked off by cones or a large rug) in which families can take turns tossing the cube and completing the sentence.
7. **Place this activity next to the Family Resources Station**, where a smaller version of this cube will be available for families to take home.
